The Rhône Valley takes you on a journey of discovery through two very distinct vineyards, offering you a very different oenological experience.

The northern Rhône Valley, which stretches from Vienne to Valence, enjoys a continental climate with Mediterranean influences.

It is home to some prestigious appellations (Côte- Rôtie, Condrieu, Saint-Joseph, Hermitage, etc.) and some of the world's leading wine producers.

(Chapoutier, Guigal ...)

The southern Rhône Valley, from Montélimar to Avignon, enjoys a typically Mediterranean climate.

The Châteauneuf-du-Pape AOC is undoubtedly its star wine., its flagship.

But your trip wouldn't be complete without a tour of the vineyards of the Rhône's tributary valleys: the Drôme with the Diois, part of the Gard around Nîmes to taste the Costières-de-Nîmes wines, the Calavon to discover the Ventoux AOC and the right bank of the Basse-Durance for the Lubéron appellation.
